

Mycenaean Bibliography

The main line of succession of bibliographies for Minoan and Mycenaean writing includes the following, and forms a continuous, non-overlapping, and reasonably complete reference to the significant and insignificant work in the field.

It is to be expected that the series of bibliographies in *Minos* is to continue. There are of course other compilations of value, especially the series begun by Ventris, Chadwick, and Palmer, *Studies in Mycenaean Inscriptions and Dialect*, (I) 1955, and II 1956, which should continue to provide most useful indexes as well as bibliography. The purpose of the present series is not to replace all these, but to present prompt and frequent report of the most recent work. This sheet is prepared not as news, however, but to take the place of the original mineographed sheets at the head of the *Continuations*.* The titles in the original sheets which a perfunctory search missed in the bibliographies listed above are repeated here.

*Note on pagination: Let the seven original sheets be given the numbers iii-ix; this sheet is numbered 1-2, let Continuation No. 1 be p. 3; let No. 2 be pp. 5-6; let No. 3 be p. 7; let No. 4 be pp. 9-10; let No. 5 be p. 11; let the tentative texts of the tablets found at Pylos, 1955 be pp. 13-14; let No. 6 be pp. 15-16. In some copies then there will be no pages 4, 8, or 12.
