Primera Plana, 7:406 (10 Nov. 1970) 32. La piedra de la discordia, on the Metcalf stone.

Hellenic Chronicle, --April 1972. "Discovery of a small lead stele in a river bed near Anoskeli [near Kissamos]... Accoridng to reports, the lead stele measured 6.5 cm. by 6.5 cm and was engraved with Lenear B symbols and letters of the Cadmean Pheonician Alphabet. It is believed to date from the 6th Century B.C."

Annular Newsletter (Dedicated to Planetary Astronomy, Archeology, and Related Sciences). In 5:3 (Autumn 1970), a horns of consecration plus double axe yields Minoan evidence for "Canopy Symbols of Archaeology." In 5:4 (Winter 1971), the same works for "Periodic Canopy Patterns." In 6:1 (Winter 1972), the Phaistos Disk (unsolved), a pendant from the Shaft Graves, and a cup from Crete provide materials for "Canopy Cryptography." It seemed only fair to send the "Crypto-Mycenaean Boars' Tusk Helmet" from Nestor (396, July 1965) to which was added a "Bore's Tooth Helmet" and a Tholos Tomb (in 6:3, Summer 1972).
