We are pleased to report that Michel Lejeune, Professor Emeritus at the Sorbonne, has been awarded a doctorate honoris causa at the University of Louvain-la-Neuve. In connection with those ceremonies, Professor Lejeune gave a conference (13 March 1980) on the subject of "l'épigraphie gauloise."

A symposium will be held on May 8-10 in Minneapolis honoring William A. McDonald, Regent's Professor of Classical Archaeology, upon his retirement from the University of Minnesota. The program will include lectures by Professors Sterling Dow, Richard Hope Simpson, James R. Wiseman, Thomas W. Jacobsen and Homer A. Thompson, as well as closing remarks by Professor McDonald himself. There will also be a joint paper given by a group of Professor McDonald's graduate students.
