### *Future Lectures and Conferences*

The 15th International Symposium of Excavations, Surveys, and Archaeometry in Turkey will be held May 24-28, 1993, at the National Library, Ankara, Turkey. The symposium is sponsored by the Republic of Turkey, the Ministry of Culture, and the General Directorate of Monuments and Museums.
