#### *From the Editors*

As this issue is going to press, *Nestor* is celebrating its **39th birthday**, with cake, flowers, and all. Yes, it was February 1957... when a "Mycenaean Bibliography," soon to be named *Nestor*, was first put together and circulated in 150 copies. It has been produced and circulated with a remarkable regularity ever since. Best wishes, then, for many more decades of *Nestor*. Can you imagine life without it?

***Nestor* as a database:** The bibliographic contents of *Nestor* from 1957 to 1994 (ca. 30,000 entries) continue to be available via anonymous FTP from cica.cica.indiana.edu, path /pub/archaeology. The same materials are also available on diskettes for Macintosh and PCs from the current *Nestor* address, at \$ 21.00 for U.S. addresses, \$ 30.00 for overseas (or \$ 4.00 and 6.50 per diskette, respectively). Remember that the bibliography is in structured ASCII files that you can easily import to a database program of your choice. More detailed instructions are provided at both the FTP site and on each diskette. *The 1995 bibliography will be ready for distribution from the FTP site and on diskette in April '96.* The cost of the diskette is \$ 4.50 for U.S. addresses and \$ 6.00 for overseas. Checks or money orders in all cases should be written to the University of Cincinnati and mailed to *Nestor*. If you have not paid your 1996 subscription dues for the monthly *Nestor* yet, and you wish to receive any diskettes, including the 1995 one, you may add the value of the diskettes to your subscription check, and indicate so in your order.

The remaining copies of the ***International Directory of Aegean Prehistorians (IDAP***, 1995 edition) are now available from *Nestor* at \$ 10.00 (for U.S. addresses) and \$ 12.00 (overseas). They will be sold on a first come first served basis, so hurry! Checks should be made payable to the University of Cincinnati, and mailed to *Nestor* (see address in masthead).
