http://stream.blg.uc.edu/csc/index.html – the Keimelia Web page for the study collection of the Department of Classics of the University of Cincinnati. This collection consists of antiquities ranging in date from the Neolithic to the modern period collected primarily from Greece and Turkey. The primary purpose of the collection is to act as a chronological and typological study group for pottery and minor arts. It houses a considerable assembly of sherds from Lerna, Troy, and Amuq. In addition, over 200 silver and bronze coins from Greece and Italy are in the collection and remain to be added to this catalog.
