Grants and Fellowships

On 28 February 2003 applications are due for the **Michael Ventris Memorial Award** of up to £1500 to be awarded to postgraduate students or young scholars who have obtained a doctorate within the past eight years in the field of Mycenaean civilization or kindred subjects. Typewritten application should be sent to The Secretary, Institute of Classical Studies, Senate House, Malet Street, London WC1E 7HU, United Kingdom. Application should include age, qualifications, academic record, an outline of the proposed work, and the names and addresses of two referees, who should at the same time be asked to write independently in support of the application.

On 15 March 2003 applications are due for the **Mary Hamilton Swindler Memorial Prize** of \$5000 in the field of ancient painting in the Mediterranean and Near East to be awarded to either a PhD candidate in the dissertation preparation phase, or a post-doctoral scholar not more than three years from graduation. Application should be sent to The Mary Hamilton Swindler Memorial Prize Committee, Department of Classical and Near Eastern Archaeology, Bryn Mawr College, Bryn Mawr, PA 19010. Application should include a dissertation prospectus, a comprehensive account of the candidate's education and training, as well as studies or experience in the field of ancient painting, three supporting letters from qualified professionals, and any materials or additional information of possible interest to the Committee. Applications will be judged on the aims of the research and its relevance to the field of the prize, and on inclusion of cutting edge material.

On 25 January 2003 pre-registration and applications for grants are due for the **9th Annual Meeting of the European Association of Archaeologists (EAA AM 2003)**, to be held in St. Petersburg, Russia from 10-14 September 2003. On 1 April 2003 session or round table proposals are due; on 15 May 2003 final registration is due, including paper or poster proposals, request for visa support, and payment of the registration fee, for hotel accommodation, and 50% for the pre-meeting excursion of your choice; on 15 July 2003 all outstanding payments and late registrations are due (surcharge of \$10); on 25 August 2003 information on arrival details is due. Prospective participants are warned to make their plans early for this meeting in order to obtain the entry visa for travel to Russia which is necessary for most foreign citizens and to secure a suitable hotel room. English must be used for all forms, proposals, and abstracts; paper presentations may be in other languages, provided this is announced and an abstract in English is provided.
