### *Grants and Fellowships*

On 15 November 2003 applications must be postmarked for the following fellowship to the **American School of Classical Studies at Athens (ASCSA)** for the academic year 2004–2005:

National Endowment for the Humanities Fellowships for 2004-2005: for postdoctoral scholars and professionals in relevant fields, U.S. citizens or foreign nationals who have lived in the U.S. for the three years immediately preceding the application deadline; five to ten months in duration coinciding with the American ASCSA's academic year, September to June; up to \$35,000.

On 1 December 2003, 1 April 2004, and 1 September 2004 applications are due for:

Wiener Laboratory Research Associateships: for well-defined research projects at the laboratory; up to \$5,000.

On 15 January 2004 applications are due for both membership to ASCSA and the following fellowships for which students and scholars of Aegean prehistory may be eligible:

Regular Members: for graduate students in classical studies and ancient Mediterranean studies and related fields (e.g., history of art, anthropology, prehistory, etc.), who, preferably,

have completed at least one year of graduate work; \$8,840 plus room at Loring Hall on the grounds of ASCSA, board, and waiver of ASCSA fees.

The Jacob Hirsch: for a PhD candidate or a recent PhD from the U.S. or Israel whose dissertation or research project requires a lengthy residence in Greece; \$8,840 plus room, board, and waiver of ASCSA fees.

Wiener Laboratory Fellowships: for graduate students or postdoctoral scholars working on well defined projects in skeletal, faunal, geoarchaeological, or environmental studies; \$15,500 to \$25,000.

Mellon (East European) Research Fellowships: for scholars from Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, and Slovakia in any field of classical studies or post-classical studies.

Solow Summer Research Fellowships 2004: for senior (postdoctoral) scholars working towards publication of material from sites excavated under the auspices of ASCSA; up to three months; up to \$1,500 per month.

Summer Program Fellowships: for graduate and undergraduate students and for high school and college teachers. In summer 2004, this 3 1/2 week session will explore the sites and monuments of Turkey.

On 22 February 2004 applications are due for:

School Advanced Fellowships: for students who have completed the Regular Program or one year as a Student Associate Member; \$8,840 plus room at Loring Hall on the grounds of ASCSA, board, and waiver of ASCSA fees.

On 31 December 2003 applications are due for the **Council of American Overseas Research Centers (CAORC) Multi-Country Research Fellowships**: support for PhD candidates and senior scholars in the humanities, social sciences, or allied natural sciences whose research has regional or trans-regional significance and requires travel to several countries, at least one of which hosts a participating American overseas research center; up to \$9,000. On 1 January 2004 applications are due for the **Margo Tytus Visiting Scholars Program** in the fields of archaeology, history, or philology at the University of Cincinnati, Classics Department, tenable during the academic year from 1 October 2004 through 31 May 2005. Tytus Fellows will ordinarily be at least five years beyond receipt of the PhD, and will come to Cincinnati to pursue their own research. The minimum and maximum terms for Long Term Fellows are one academic quarter (two and a half months) to one academic year; Short Term Fellows will reside in Cincinnati for one to two months. Both categories of Tytus Fellows will receive housing, a transportation allowance, and office space; a monthly stipend of \$1,000 is additionally provided for Long Term Fellows. ### ***Call for Papers***

On 1 November 2003 abstracts are due for the 2004 Visiting Scholar Conference entitled **We Are What We Eat: Archaeology, Food, and Identity**, to be held on 12-13 March 2004 at Southern Illinois University at Carbondale. Archaeologists working in a wide range of time periods and areas with a variety of methodological and theoretical approaches, as well as scholars working in fields outside of but relevant to archaeology (including sociocultural anthropology, sociology, and history) are invited to submit abstracts (150-250 words) concentrating on the cultural roles and contexts of food, and discussing how tastes, taboos, food procurement strategies, modes of cooking and dining, and discard habits are intertwined with the construction and maintenance of individual and group identities, especially in relationship to the social significance of daily consumption practices. Potential topics may include, but need not be limited to:

- Theoretical approaches to the study of food and foodways
  - Food and social status, ethnicity, prestige, gender, age, role, religion, class, etc.
  - The social and labor roles associated with various types of food production, preparation, and consumption
  - The limits placed by ecological and biological constraints on the expression of identity through food
  - The effect of archaeologists' own identities on interpretations of foodways (e.g.: to what extent is subjectivity an issue? If it does affect interpretations, how?)
  - How different facets of identity may be expressed at different stages of food production and use (for example: gender may be expressed in food procurement and preparation practices, but not in actual consumption habits)
  - The extent to which culturally specific food patterns may be generalized across societies
  - The extent to which archaeologists working in different areas and time periods can reasonably expect to explore identity through food practices (for example: can prehistorians address ethnicity? Can hunter-gatherer archaeologists discuss status?)
