The editors of *Nestor* are saddened to report the death of Günter Neumann of the University of Würzburg. Professor Neumann was a distinguished scholar in the field of Cypriot syllabic epigraphy and published extensively on other languages within the chronological and geographic scope of *Nestor*, including the Phaistos disc, 'Hieroglyphic' Cretan, Linear A, and Linear B.
