On 1 December 2005 preliminary registration forms are due for an International Colloquium entitled **Before Hippocrates: Health, Disease and Medicine in the Prehistoric Aegean**, to be held at the University of Birmingham Medical School on 13-15 September 2007, sponsored by the University of Birmingham, the Society for Ancient Medicine, and the Holley Martlew Archaeological Foundation. The aims of the symposium are to examine the possible origins of Classical and Hellenistic healing cults and Hippocratic practices in earlier healing traditions and in a traditional body of knowledge, much of which may already have been known by the Late Bronze Age, as well as to expand the understanding of Minoan and Mycenaean health, disease and medicine and to build upon the advanced scientific work in the field of artefact analysis and the study of human skeletal remains that has been undertaken in the last ten years. This multi-disciplinary Colloquium aims to bring together archaeologists, Linear B scholars, medical historians, physical anthropologists, palaeopathologists, as well as other scientists working in the fields of nuclear aDNA, organic residue analysis, and stable isotope analysis, together with others who have a general interest. Sessions might include the following general themes:

- Disease Patterns and Health Status
- Religion, Cult, and Healing
- The Influence of Overseas Contacts
- Diet and Food
- Disease and Medicine in the Archaeological Record and Linear B
- Human Skeletal Remains
- Ancient Biomolecules

- Homeric Medicine – what was it?

Obituaries

The editors of *Nestor* are saddened to report the death of Professor Elizabeth Milburn Schofield. Professor Schofield directed study and publication of the excavations at Ayia Irini, Kea, and participated in the study and publication of the site of Lefkandi, in addition to her own publications on these subjects and on the Cyclades in the early Late Bronze Age.

The editors of *Nestor* are saddened to report the death of Professor Manfred Korfmann. In addition to early field work at Demircihuyuk and Besiktepe in northwestern Turkey and recent investigations at Didigora and Udabno in Georgia, Professor Korfmann directed 18 seasons of excavations at Troy, with special emphasis on the lower city; he also founded the journal, *Studia Troica*, in which the results of his own and other research in the Troad have been published.
