Gaius Iulius Apolinarius agrees that he has received from $|^{10}$ Petronia Sarapias as a deposit free from any risk: women's clothing evaluated at three hundred silver drachmas and golden jewelry in kind (weighing) altogether thirty-two *tetartai* (*ca. 56 grams*), which he agrees to keep at his own house and which he will return $|^{15}$ to her whenever she demands them back without delay or else he will pay her back in accordance with the law on deposits, while the right of execution (of the claim) belongs to Petronia Sarapias from all that Gaius Iulius Apolinarios owns just as if by virtue of a legal decision.
