Apynchis agrees that he is immediately liable to seizure, until he fulfills (*BL* 8, p. 14) everything and pays back the sum of all the aforementioned wages plus a 50% (penalty) as well as the damages and expenses and an additional fine (*to the state*) of a hundred silver drachmas, |5 while the right of execution (of the claim) belongs to Martialis from Apynchis and from all his property, just as if by virtue of a legal decision. When (Apynchis) does everything (in the contract) without reproach, Martialis (agrees that he) will dissolve this contract when the time is up and Apynchis |10 has executed (the contract) without reproach, and (Martialis agrees that) he will not take anything (from Apynchis at that time), otherwise (Martialis agrees that) he will pay the same fine.
