We agree with one another on the following: |¹⁰ given that Ischyras and Didyme have handed over to Isidoros and Apollonarion their daughter Syairous for four years and four months from the month of August of the coming second |¹⁵ year of Emperor Caesar Nerva Traianus Augustus Germanicus to be obedient in what service she is ordered to do, in the house and elsewhere, without reproach and without complaint, |²⁰ returning safe and sound whatever she receives except for obvious wear and tear and an act of God ... Isidoros ...
