... |³ let Dios give in return to |⁴ Ptolemaios also called Petheus on the western side |⁵ ... house ... on the |⁶ eastern side half a single-storied house |⁷ and on the western side there is(?) a two-storied |⁸ small house and on the western side |⁹ plots, in which there is a pigeon-house at the south-western(?) end |¹⁰ and on the western side of Dios' plot |¹¹ an entrance and exit, about which Ptolemaios |¹² also called Petheus disputed with Dios,

Settlement(?) proper

Ptolemaios also called Petheus having fallen short |¹³ of his claims agrees on the spot that |¹⁴ neither he nor those acting on his behalf will proceed against Dios or |¹⁵ those acting on his behalf about the entrance and exit |¹⁶ in any way. And Dios will have the right to incorporate |¹⁷ (the entrance and exit) into his own plots, to build upon it, and |¹⁸ to use it in any way he chooses, unhampered. |¹⁹ And Ptolemaios also called Petheus (agrees that he) will perforce |²⁰ annul and withdraw(?) immediately ...
