Considerans

We agree with one another on the following: since both Demetrius and Isidoros have received from Chairemon, both from Chairemon himself and from others in accordance with (firstly) the prior |¹⁰ payments through the exchange bank of Narkissos son of Archias, and (secondly) the payments through the bank of Demetrios and Isidoros themselves, and (thirdly) the payment that occurred just now by Chairemon himself executed through the aforementioned exchange bank of Narkissos, thirteen talents of silver and interest, which they loaned to Chairemon himself |¹⁵ in accordance with a contract (*synchoresis*) through the record office in Pharmouthi in the eighth year of Imperator Tiberius Claudius Caesar Augustus Germanicus,

Agreement proper

(they agree) that the contract (*synchoresis*) of loan is invalid by the payment through the aforementioned exchange |²⁰ bank of Narkissos and that neither Demetrios nor Isidoros nor anyone else on their behalf will take action against Chairemon concerning the aforementioned loan and interest nor concerning any other matter at all, either written or unwritten, from previous times until the current day ...
