Addressee

To ..., *neokoros* of the great Sarapis ... former tribune of the third cohort ... priest, *archidikastes*, and officer in charge of the *chrematistai* |²⁰ and the other courts,

Parties

from Senthoy's son of Hephaistos from Herakleopolis, the metropolis of the Herakleopolite nome south of Memphis, and from Petesis son of Horis, whose mother is |²⁵ Soeris, from the village of Thmoinephtha in the same nome.

Agreement proper

Petesis agrees to work together with Senthoy's wherever he orders him, in the mining craft for twelve months from the month of Pachon of |³⁰ the present sixteenth year of Emperor Hadrianus the Lord, for the agreed wages for the whole time of one hundred and eighty silver drachmas, from which Petesis received on the spot from him |³⁵ one hundred and sixty silver drachmas from hand to hand (*in cash*), the remaining twenty silver drachmas he will give him in the last of the aforementioned months, and he will supply him ...
