Loan contract (draft of *BGU* 4.1055; *synchoresis*) March 31, 13 BC

(a) *Addressee* 

|<sup>1</sup> To Protarchos, who is in charge of the tribunal,

(b1) *Party 1* |<sup>2</sup> from Apollonios, the son of Herakleides,

(b2) *Party 2* and from  $|^3$  Ammonios, the son of Anoubion, a Persian of the *epigone*.

## (c) Agreement about the receipt of the loan

 $|^4$  Ammonios agrees that he has received from Apollonios  $|^5$  in cash and not through a bank as a loan:  $|^6$  64 Ptolemaic silver drachmas without interest,

## (d) Agreement about repayment of the loan

which (*loan*) he also agrees that he will pay back within  $|^7$  three months from the month Pharmouthi of the present  $|^8$  17th year of Caesar (*Augustus*) without delay,

## (e) Penalty clause

 $|^9$  or else he agrees that he is immediately liable to seizure and can be held under arrest  $|^{10}$  until he pays the sum along with half as much again and  $|^{11}$  for the time that has gone beyond (*the due date*) the interest of two drachmas  $|^{12}$  (*per 100 drachmas per month*) in accordance with the statute, while the right of execution (*of the claim*) belongs to Apollonios  $|^{13}$  from Ammonios himself and from all his belongings  $|^{14}$  just as if by virtue a legal decision, while all safe-conducts (*and*) every kind of protection he adduces are ineffective.

## (f) Memorandum about another loan

 $|^{15}$  This loan is separate from  $|^{16}$  the other (*debt*) that the same Ammonios together with  $|^{17}$  his mother owes Apollonios in accordance with another agreement:  $|^{18}$  100 drachmas.
