Loan contract (*synchoresis*)  
April 12, 13 BC

(a) *Addressee*  
<sup>|26</sup> To Protarchos,

(b1) *Party 1*  
<sup>|27</sup> from Gaius Iulius Philios,

(b2) *Party 2*  
and from Agathokles, the son of Sarasinus (?), and from Lykarion, <sup>|28</sup> the son of Apollonios, both Persians of the *epigone*.

(c) *Agreement proper*  
Concerning the points at issue, Agathokles <sup>|29</sup> and Lykarion agree that they have received from Gaius Iulius Philios through the money-changing bank of Kastor an interest-free loan (BL 5.15) <sup>|30</sup> of 70 Ptolemaic silver drachmas, which they also agree to pay back within three <sup>|31</sup> months starting from the 1st of Pachon of the present 17th year of Caesar (*Augustus*), by giving each day <sup>|32</sup> the five obols due (*each day*) until the aforesaid balance is paid <sup>|33</sup> without skipping a single payment, and they agree to do this without (*the need for*) a trial <sup>|34</sup> or any dispute,

(d) *Penalty clause*  
and if not, they agree that they are liable to seizure and can be held under arrest on whichever day <sup>|35</sup> they skip, without waiting for the time apportioned <sup>|36</sup> to them, until they pay the entire sum or whatever will be owed (*at that time*) along with half as much again <sup>|37</sup> and for the time that has passed (*the deadline*) the interest of two drachmas (*per 100 drachmas per month*) in accordance with the statute, while the right of execution (*of the claim*) belongs <sup>|38</sup> to Gaius Iulius Philios from the two debtors, who are each other's guarantors for payment, and from one and from whomever he chooses <sup>|39</sup> and from all their belongings just as if by virtue of a legal decision, and also from the two wood-selling workshops belonging to one of them, <sup>|40</sup> Agathokles, in the <sup>|41</sup> Delta (*quarter*), one in the area called Kamptra near the Kibotos, and the other in the <sup>|42</sup> area called Kepikon Balaneion, and they also agree until they pay <sup>|43</sup> to make sure that the (*wood-selling workshops*) remain unalienated and unencumbered by debt, and if a risk arises <sup>|44</sup> concerning them ..., even so this loan is free <sup>|45</sup> from any risk, while all safeguards (*and*) every kind of protection they adduce are ineffective,

(e) *Memorandum about other loans*  
<sup>|46</sup> while the legal action remains for Gaius Iulius Philios against the same concerning the <sup>|47</sup> other debts they owe him and ... <sup>|48</sup> ... in accordance with other documents.

(f) *Joint request for registration*  
We request (*registration*).

(g) *Date*  
Year 17 of Caesar (*Augustus*), Pharmouthi 17.
