Wetnursing contract (*synchoresis*) May 16, 14 BC

(a) Agreement proper

 $|^1 \dots |^2 \dots$ in the times of Caesar (*Augustus*) for her own slave child, Agalmation, so as $|^3$ to be nursed by the same Martha, and that no avenue for legal action $|^4$ is left open to Marion or anyone else on her behalf against Souerous, $|^5$ either on account of the matter of the aforementioned agreement, as to which she agrees that it is ineffective, or anything else whatsoever, written or unwritten, $|^6$ from the previous times up until the present day, and that Martha will not initiate legal proceedings against Marion $|^7$ concerning the wages for nursing for the intervening time period or against the slave child, $|^8$ in any way whatsoever, and furthermore that whosoever will proceed against Souerous or breaks $|^9$ the contract, she will remove immediately at her own expense, and, apart from the fact that the matters agreed upon are valid, $|^{10}$ she agrees that she is also liable, if she transgresses (*any of these provisions*), for the damages and the statutory penalty (*to the state*).
