Contract for the repayment of a loan and cancellation of a *paramone* service (*synchoresis*)
May 4. 10 BC

(a) *Addressee*

¹ To Protarchos,

(b1) *Part 1*

² from Heliodoros, the son of Heliodoros ³ alias Aphrodeisios, from the deme of Althaea,

(b2) *Party 2*

⁴ and from Didymos and Seuthes, ⁵ both sons of Didymos, and from the ⁶ wife of Didymos, Theodote, the daughter ⁷ of Theodoros, with as guardian her husband.

(c) *Agreement proper*

⁸ Heliodoros agrees that he has received ⁹ from Didymos and Seuthes and ¹⁰ Theodote in cash and not through a bank the loans ¹¹ he loaned then in accordance with two agreements ¹² made through the same tribunal ¹³ in the 13th year of Caesar (*Augustus*) ¹⁴ in Phamenoth, one for ¹⁵ 660 drachmas and their interest, ¹⁶ the other for ¹⁷ 100 drachmas, and he agrees that ¹⁸ both agreements are ineffective as well as ¹⁹ the bank drafts made for them ²⁰ through the bank of Zoilos ²¹⁻²⁴ along with the *paramone* contract for the son of Didymos and Theodote, Didymos, indicated in the agreement for 100 drachmas, and ²⁵ Heliodoros agrees that he ²⁶ nor anyone else on his behalf will proceed against Didymos ²⁷ and Seuthes and Theodote, ²⁸ neither about the same things nor ²⁹ about any other debt ³⁰ or claim whatsoever, written ³¹ or unwritten, from the previous ³² times until the present ³³ day, and he agrees that he will also not proceed against the son, ³⁴ Didymos, about what ³⁵ concerns the *paramone* contract in any way,

(d) *Penalty clause*

³⁶ or else, apart from the fact that the things agreed upon are effective, ³⁷ he agrees to be liable ³⁸ himself, in case he transgresses (*any of these provisions*), to the damages ³⁹ and the statutory penalty (*to the state*).
