Contract for the repayment of a loan (*synchoresis*)
11/10 BC

(a) *Addressee*

|¹ To Protarchos,

(b1) *Party 1*

|² from Marcus Tigellius Ialysos,

(b2) *Party 2*

and from Eros, the slave of |³ Diodoros, sent to make this |⁴ agreement by Kalathos alias Philemon, the slave of the same Diodoros (?).

(c) *Agreement proper*

|⁵ Marcus Tigellius Ialysos agrees that he, after having |⁶ been persuaded by Eros, has received from him |⁷ through the bank of Hermias in the name of Kalathos |⁸ 40 Ptolemaic silver drachmas, which he loaned to |⁹ Kalathos in accordance with an agreement through the |¹⁰ daily record of the record office in the past as well as |¹¹ the whole interest for the time since, and he agrees that the |¹² agreement concerning the loan and the bank draft made |¹³ through the same bank are ineffective, and Marcus Tigellius Ialysos agrees that he will not proceed, |¹⁴ nor anyone else on his behalf against Kalathos |¹⁵ alias Philemon, neither concerning the same (*loan*) nor concerning |¹⁶ any other debt or claim at all nor concerning any written or unwritten |¹⁷ matter whatsoever, from the previous times until the |¹⁸ present day,

(d) *Penalty clause*

or else, apart from the fact that the things agreed upon are effective, |¹⁹ he agrees that if he transgresses (*any of these provisions*) he is liable to the damages and the statutory penalty (*to the state*).

(e) *Date*

Year 20 of Caesar (*Augustus*), ... 29.
